Les Anges Sauvignon Blanc 2019

€6.50 €22.50

Region: Loire Valley

Grape variety: Sauvignon Blanc

Grassy, zesty Sauvignon displaying exuberant bright citrus and gooseberry flavours with hint of nettle.

Les Mougins Picpoul de Pinet 2019

€26.00

Region: Languedoc, Picpoul de Pinet AOC

Grape variety: Piquepoul de Pinet

Light and floral with tangy palate featuring green apple and pear and marked acidity.

Eidosela Albariño 2019

€30.00

Region: Galicia, Rias Baixas

Grape variety: Albariño

Full of summery flavours: apricots, honeysuckle and juicy white flesh nectarine; the palate has bright citrus freshness and herbal notes of fennel.

J.P. & Benoit Droin, Chablis 2019

€47.00

Region: Burgundy (Chablis AOC)

Grape variety: Chardonnay

Pure and ample Chablis from an excellent vintage, perfectly combining ripeness with austerity. Silky smooth on the palate, with a deep core of citrus fruit, racy acidity as well as notes of oyster shell and flint.

Region: Sicily (area of Marsala)

Grape variety: Grillo

Crisp and refreshing with aromas of ripe citrus, pear and wild herbs; it has a soft and subtle palate, balanced out by the zesty, mouth-watering acidity.

La Jara Pinot Grigio 2019

Region: Veneto

Grape variety: Pinot Grigio

Dry and elegant with an array of stone fruits, zingy grapefruit, and subtle bitter almond on the finish; soft and rounded with great concentration of flavours.

Immichm – Batterieberg C.A.I. 2018

Region: Mosel

Grape variety: Riesling

A Kabinett in style, this is an elegant and characterful Riesling. Floral notes mingle with stony (slatey) aromas. The palate is concentrated with ripe citrus, crunchy green apple and saline finish.

A medium bodied red blend of traditional varieties from Douro Valley. Easy drinking with ripe red and black fruit flavours and a hint of spice.

Martinez Lacuesta Cosecha 2018

€26.00

Region: Rioja

Grape variety: Tempranillo, Graciano, Mazuelo

Smooth and dry, this medium-bodied Rioja offers vibrant cherry and ripe plum flavours with notes of spice and earth.

Il Poggio Chianti 2019

Region: Tuscany, Chianti DOCG

Grape variety: Sangiovese, others

Bright ruby in colour with signature flavours of sour cherry, balsamic notes of dried herbs (oregano) and refreshing acidity.

Quinta Milú 2019

Region: Ribera del Duero

Grape variety: Tempranillo

Fresh and juicy Ribera with flavours of cherries, plums, damson fruit and freshly cracked black pepper; it has a lively acidity and pleasant tannic grip; delicious.

Domaine Roche – Audran, Côtes – du – Rhône “Tradition” 2019

Region: Rhône Valley, Côtes – du – Rhône AOC

Grape variety: Grenache, Syrah

Bright red cherry fruit with a complex peppery spice component and rich red and black fruit flavours.

Terroir Unico Malbec 2019

Region: Mendoza, Gualatallary (Tupungato) Uco Valley

Grape variety: Malbec

Lively and fresh style of Malbec; unoaked and fruit driven, with flavours of cherry, blueberry and plum, perhaps a hint of violets; the palate is juicy and soft.

Martinez Lacuesta Rioja Reserva 2011

€38.00

Region: Rioja

Grape variety: Tempranillo, Graciano, Mazuelo

Toasty and creamy nose with spicy touches of oak. Powerful and meaty palate with red fruits and complexity from ageing.

Château Saransot Dupré, Crú Bourgeois 2016

€45.00

Region: Bordeaux, Listrac – Médoc AOC

Grape variety: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Carménère

Flavours of chocolate, cherry and plum with rounded and soft mouthfeel. The palate is deep and savoury, packed with fruit, with a full body and a fabulous finish.
